We sincerely hope you are having a wonderful summer and enjoying our beautiful lakes!

The **CSLOA** works in partnership with the **CSCD** and the **CSVFD** on multiple occasions. Each entity is responsible for different aspects of lake living.

In this letter we would like to clarify the distinctions in these acronyms.

CSLOA: Cordry Sweetwater Lot Owners Association

- * This association primarily organizes social activities.
- * Clubhouse: 8751 Nineveh Road (green building by Smokey the Bear) Cordrysweetwater.org
- * Membership dues are \$75 per year. This money is used to maintain the clubhouse and the library, and we also sponsor many activities including 4th of July fireworks (\$11,000 this year), the Ox roast (see information in the newsletter to become a vendor), chili cook off, spaghetti dinner, pumpkin carving, Santa workshop, bike parade, beach block party, educational events, and we hope to organize a 5K/ half marathon and Casino night in the upcoming year!
- * We are open for suggestions for activities, and invite you to attend meetings which are open to all freeholders on the Fourth Thursday of each month at 7:00 in the clubhouse.

CSCD: Cordry Sweetwater Conservancy District

* This organization is the governing entity of

the district.

- * Office: 8377 Cordry Drive (where you pay your water bill and get boat decals) 317-933-2893, CSCD-IN.org
- * The CSCD board of directors meets monthly. Six commissions report to the board with recommendations concerning their respective fields. These commissions are Roads, Water, Ecology, Security, Finances, and Building.
- * The district owns the lakes and park areas and employs about a dozen full time employees that keep the district running. They are responsible for boat patrol, beach, and marina attendants.
- * Meetings are open to freeholders on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 at the office.

CSVFD: Cordry Sweetwater Volunteer Fire Department

- * Fire, rescue and EMS service
- * 101 Firehouse Drive non emergency # 317-933-2224
- * Community events: annual garage sale, haunted trail, pancake breakfast, Easter egg hunt.
- * \$75 donation covers free service in the event of a fire (excluding illegal activities or unattended fire) as well as free basic life support ambulance transport to JMH or CMH
- * Public meetings are held third Thursday of each month at 7:30
